PROPHET MUHAMMAD'S MEMORABLE DISCOURSE AT THE FAREWELL PILGRIMAGE, !!th Dhul Hajj(March -- 630.)

Ye People! Hearken to my words; for I know not whether after this year, I shall ever be amongst you here again.

Your lives and Property are sacred and inviolable amongst one another until the end of time.

The Lord hath ordained to every man the share of his inheritance a Testament is not lawful to the prejudice of heirs.

The child belongeth to the . parents: and the violator of Wedlock shall be stoned.

Whoever claimeth falsely another for his father, or another for his master, the curse of God and the angels, and of all Mankind shall rest upon him.

YE PEOPLE! Ye have rights demandable of your wives, and they have rights demandable of you. Upon them it is incumbent not to violate conjugal faith nor commit any act of open impropriety; which things if they do, ye have authority to shut them up in separate apartments But if they refrain therefrom, clothe them and feed them suitably. And treat your Women well: for they are with you as captives and prisoners they; have not power over anything as as regards themselves. And ye have verily taken them on the security of God; and have made their persons lawful unto you by the words of God.

AND YOUR SLAVES! See that ye feed them with such food as ye eat yourselves; and clothe them with the stuff ye wear. And if they commit a fault ye are not inclined to forgive, then sell them, for they are the servants of the Lord and are not to be tormented.

YE PEOPLE! Hearken to my speech and comprehend the same. Know that every Moslem is the brother of every other Moslem. ALL OF YOU ARE ON THE SAME EQUALITY(and as he pronounced these words, he raised his arms aloft and placed the forefinger of one hand on the forefinger of the other) Ye are one brotherhood.

Know YE WHAT MONTH THIS IS? -What territory is this? What day? (To eath question the people gave the appropriate answer, viz The sacred month, the sacred territory, the great day of Pilgrimage) after every one of these replies Prophet added" Even thus sacred and inviolable hath God made the life and the property of each of you unto the other, until ye meet your Lord.

:LET HIM THAT IS PRESENT, tell it unto him that is absent. Haply he that shall be told, may remember better than he who hath heard it.

Prophet then proceeded to recite the 37th and 38th verses of the 9th Sura of Quran.

AND NOW, continued Prophet Muhammad, on this very day hath time performed its cycle, and returned to the disposition thereof existing at the noment when God created the Heavens and the Earth.

EUROPEAN VISITORS TO HOLY MECCA

IBN-BATTUTAH is said to have visited Mecca in October 1326. Of the European visitors to Mecca the first in series was VARTHEMA, an Italian traveller, who arrived in Medina on May 11/1503(see the itinerary of Ludovico di Varthema of Bolgoma.tr. J.W.Winters, London 1928) The second in series was BADIA, he missed Medina but arrived Mecca February 1807. The third one BURCKHARDT entered Medina January 27, 1814 when the city was under Ottoman suzerainty to Egyptian rule. He spent there 3 monthsbut 2 were marred with sickness of fever (vide Burckhardt:Travel in Arabia London 1829) Another Richard Burton who visited Medina 39 years after Burckhardt. Population is described by him as 16000 to 18000. He was a British visitor to the Holy Lands. (vide R.F. Burton 'Personal narrative of a pilgrimage to Medina & Mecca 1893)

1) The first to venture into the lion's den of Islam was a Bolognese named Ludovico di Varthema. In Damascus where he made his start to learn the Moorish language, Varthema adopted Islam, assumed the name YUNIS and managed through bribery to enroll in the Mamluk garrison. The Mamluk himself was a christian regegade. This was in 1503 when Mamluk dynasty ruled over Egypt & Syria.

When the pilgrimage time came Yunis was given a post in the Caravan as an escort. The Caravan which he claimed composed 40,000 men arrived at May 22. After going through the pilgrimage rites with his fellow caravaneers he lingered in the city till June 12.

- 2) More leanned than Varthema was the Spanish Badia Leblick, a student of Medicine as well as a master of Arabic. He spent several years in Morroco and egypt on unknown missions and spent money equally lavishly from equally unknown sources. He adopted the nale ALI BEY AL-ABBASI. With a retinue of servants and an ornamented rug-furbished tent the princely pilgrim joined the Egyptian caravan arriving in Mecca January 23/1807. So complete was his disguise that none ever suspecsted his nationality. Even the Sharif of the city befriended Ali Bey and on one occasion sought his assistance in we shing the Kaaba marble floor.
- 3) John Lewis Burckhardt prepared himself for the perilous task at Aleppo, where he acquired proficiency not only in Arabic but in the sciences of Koran. In mid July 1814 he entered Jeddah disguised as a beggar in rags. His name was SHAYKH IBRAHIM IBN ABDULLAH. The following 3 months he spent in the area visiting Mecca twice.

England has produced the largest number of world-renowned travellers in Arabia beginning with R.F. Burton and coming down to St. John Philby. Certain accounts of their, like Arabia Deserta by CHARLES DOUGHTY and Seven Pillars of Wisdom by T.E. Lawrence have achieved the rank of classics in English literature.

4) R.F. Eurton started the study of Arabic in Oxford and continued in India where he served in East India Company. In 1853 Royal Geographical Society approved his trip to Africa. Assuming the name of SHAYKH ABDULLAH he ;posed as a Pathan Indian Moslem to explain his foreign Arabic accent. In his Personal Narrative of a Pilgrimage(london 1855–56) he threw new light on varied aspects of Arabian life.
