## TORONTO CHAPTER ACTIVITIES REPORT

All the Tehriks for various Contributions are initiated through the meeting, programs are announced and new brothers introduced to the jamaat. Children classes are being conducted at our Missionary's residence every Saturday. In the past few months the Khuddam-ul-Ahmadiyya conducted few picnics which were a source of great enthusiasm and atheletic activities. The monthly mouthpiece of our Movement 'Ahmadiyya Gazette, Canada' is printed every month with the assistance of many a sincere brothers. Though it is complicated and time-consuming job, however, the sharing of duties makes it lot easier. The meetings of Executive Council are held once every month. Recently our Missionary-in-Charge spoke on Islam in a Rotary Club. Mosque Project is under active consideration of Toronto Ahmadies.

#### VANCOUVER JAMAAT

This Jamaat was established only two months before when Vancouver Ahmadies gathered to elect their president and the office bearers. From the right begining, however, this Jamaat has started and continued its regular communal activities. They have endeavoured to train the young children of the Jamaat and set an example for us. These children during summer vacations had been joining a daily class to learn Holy Quran and religious knowledge. After the vacations as well they had decided to join this religious class two or three times every week. Vancouver Jamaat has been gathering for Jumma prayer regularly and also arranged picnics and other social and religious gatherings on long week-ends.

#### EDMONTON JAMAAT

Edmonton Jamaat comprises few Ahmadi families, yet they are gathering for Jumaa prayer every week and arranged classes to teach members the translation of the prayer and the Holy Quran. The members of this community are contributing regularly for financing the Jamaat program to train the members and preach Islam to the others.

#### BRANTFORD JAMAAT

This report comprises the three months from June to August 1977. Most of the members including children took part in the monthly meeting which were held regularly. Children were awarded prizes according to their performance. Jamaat is taking care to train their according to the teachings of Ahmadiyyat.

Lajna Imaullah is holding their seperate meeting and training their members as well as the young Nasirat. They co-operated with Lajna Toronto. in holding Meena Bazar in which \$1000 were raised for mosque. They also arranged food for the participants of every monthly meeting.

Dear Sir,

While reading a commentary on a recently published book, I was reminded of numerous quotes from The Holy Quran, about Jesus Christ. It has been repeatedly mentioned in Suras Al-Nisa and Al-Mayyda that Jesus was a prophet of God and not God, as proclaimed by Christians. Now leading Christian theologians are forced to admit these facts that Jesus was an ordinary human being, selected by the GOD ALMIGHTY for a special cause.

The book is titled 'The Myth of God Incarnate', is authored by seven high-ranking theologians, and is published by SCM Press, London. A preface to the book says: 'In the 19th century, Western Christanity made two major new adjustments in response to important enlargements of human knowledge: It accepted that man is part of nature and has emerged within the evolution of the forms of life on this earth and it accepted that the books of the bible were written by a variety of human beings in a variety of circumstances, and cannot be accorded a verbal divine authority.' The preface says the authors " are convinced that another major theological development is called for in this last part of the 20th century."

"The need arises from growing knowledge of Christian origins and involves a recognition that Jesus was as presented in the Rible (Acts 2.21) a man approved by God' for a special role within the divine purpose and that

work for their common high goal. Together with other things, fasting helps to arise the noble feelings of sympathy and co-operation in the society. The pangs of hunger and thirst make rich people to help the poor. Moreover Muslims are asked to give alms and charity especially in Ramadan, the month of fasting. The Holy Prophet of Islam was a most liberal of the men but in Ramadan, Traditions tell us, he was more generous than a gale. The month of Ramadan is also called the month of Charity.

In Ramadan the Muslims are especially enjoined to learn, read and ponder over the Holy Quran which is a perfect guide for the Humanity. I think I must cite here some of the many Quranic verses about equality of men, mutual love and brotherhood, regard for others and sacriffice for them as these are the qualities which can help to unite the society. I will content myself to produce the translation of these verses of the Holy Quran. God asks the Holy Prophet of Islam, "Say, I am only a man like yourselves; but I have received the revelation, that you God is only one God. (Holy Quran)

In the second verse God says, "O mankind, We have created you from a male and a female; and We have made you tribes and sub-tribes that you may know one another. Verily, the most honourable among you, in the sight of Allah, is the one who is the most righteous among you. Surely Allah is All-Knowing, All-Aware. (Holy Quran Chap: 49)

Urging us to do good to the others Holy Quran says: "God commands you to do good in return for good, and (if you can avail yourself of an opportunity of doing more than mere justice) to do good without having received any benefit, and (if it benefits the occasion) you should bestow gifts with the natural kindness of kindred and forbids indecency, and manifest evil, and wrongful transgression. He admonishes you that you may take heed."

Islam in fact has made it obligatory for the rich to pay Zakat or poordue by 21/2% every year.

In many cases Muslims have to live with the non-Muslims. Islam has not overlooked such a probability. It has given the Muslims a definite teaching to do justice, co-operate, sympathize, help and love the countrymen of other denominations and creeds.

Islam is the first and the only religion to announce the Divine origin of all the religions of the world. We find this in the Holy Quran. Here God tells the Holy Prophet of Islam, "Verily, we have sent thee with the Truth, as a bearer of glad tidings and as a Warner; and there is no people to whom a Warner has not been sent."

This great truth revealed by the Quran can prove to be the basis to unite a society consisting of the people of different creeds, denominations, races and colours. For that matter Muslims are required by their religion to accept, honour and believe in the prophets and reformers of all the religions.

In the religious beliefs as well, Islam advises, we should try to find the basis for co-operation. The Quranic verse says: "Say O people of the Book (that is the Jews and Christian) come to a word equal between us and you - that we worship none but Allah, and that we associate no partner with Him, and that some of us take not others for Lords beside Allah."

Islam disbelieves in compulsion in the matter of religion. Muslims are enjoined by their religion to safegaurd the honours, lives and properties of the non-Muslims living with them.

When the Muslims migrated from Mecca to Madinah, the Holy Prophet entered into peace treaty with the Jews and the Pagan tribes of the town. This is called Treaty of Medina in History and is the first peace treaty of its kind in the history. It assured the full freedom of belief and also safeguarded the lives and properties of all the citizens of Madina.

Islam in fact literally means peace and obedience and for that matter a Muslim by all means is to develop two fundamental traits i.e. to submit himself completely to th will of God and be a peaceful member of the society and endeavour for its unification.

the later conception of him as God incarnate, the second person of the Holy Trinity living a human life, is a mythological or poetic way of expressing his significance for us."

This book consists of 10 essays edited by John Hick, professor of theology at Birmingham University and a member of the United Reformed Church. At a news conference, Hick said most scholars believe that Jesus had not presented himself as divine, "although many church meers are not aware of this."

The publication of this book has opened a major theological debate, because the traditional concept of Christ's divinity has been challenged. The critics are saying that the book presented a direct and fundamental challenge to beliefs most Christians hold precious.
